PT Suntara Gajapati has prepared a spatial plan of the effective working area, consisting of staple plant area of 24,136 ha (69.37%); indigenous feature plant of 3,480 ha (10.00%); livelihood plant area of 1,740 ha (5%); protected areas covering 4,422 ha (12.71%); and infrastructure area of 1,014 ha (2.91%). In reference to the foregoing spatial plans, the Management Unit of PT Suntara Gajapati has prepared and implemented the following management plans taking into account the principle of conservation of forests:

- 1) Taking into account the peat bog soil type, *Acacia crassicarpa* is the species cultivated as the staple crop, divided into working plots of 25 hectares and having a five-year cutting cycle. The scope of field operational activities carried out by the Management Unit Includes arrangement of working area, land preparation, planting, plant husbandry, inventory of planted forest, environmental management, and implementation of the CSR / CD program.
- 2) In meeting its ecological responsibilities the company has established and maintains protected areas such as the riparian zones (areas bordering rivers) and the Senepis Buluhala tiger conservation area. Establishment of these conservation area is in consideration that part of this work area is also the habitat of the Sumatran tiger (*Panthera tigris sumatrae*) a protected and critically endangered species for which 3,850 hectares has been set aside; and the river border areas along the Buluhala River (529 ha), Teras River (20 ha) and Santahulu River (23 ha). In addition, through inventory the Management Unit has identified and mapped the distribution of flora and fauna that are endemic, protected, rare and endangered / endangered and their habitats throughout the whole working area of PT Suntara Gajapati. Moreover, these forest protection activities have been carried out in accordance with identification by the Management Unit of potential areas of interference that include pests & plant diseases, encroachment / illegal occupation of land, and land & forest fires.

3) The local communities that surround the working area live in the villages of Desa Batu Teritip and Desa Basilam Baru. In order to improve the welfare of society in these villages and implement the CSR / CD program, the Management Unit has allocated an area for livelihood plants. In addition, it has made efforts to create employment for local people, either as permanent employees or on a daily basis. In carrying out its sustainable forest management, the Management Unit has also been careful to build a positive relationship with the people in the surrounding communities, recognizing and respecting their rights, not just related to occupational health and safety and other employee rights but also through

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other activities designed to foster equitable relations.

In accordance with the requirements of the IFCC Standard, the Management Unit of PT Suntara Gajapati has excluded from certification areas of plantation forest (6,985ha) that were established through conversion of natural forest after Dec. 31, 2010. The final scope of certification is thus 27,807 hectares.

Prior to audit stage 2, PT AJA Sertifikasi Indonesia conducted public consultation, commencing February 11, 2016, for the purpose of requesting input from all relevant stakeholders in regard to Sustainable Forest Development (SFM) Management Unit PT Suntara Gajapati, whereby the request for public consultation was uploaded to the website of PT AJA Sertifikasi Indonesia (www.ajaindonesia.com), sent to the parties via e-mail and / or mail, and published in local newspapers.

Findings on the certified client conformity with the certification requirements and description of critical issues in relation with the conformity.

Based on the audit results of Stage-2, there were two (2) non-conformity issues classified as minor. In relation to the nonconformity, the Management Unit of PT Suntara Gajapati has completed corrective action on all issues in accordance with the timetable that had been determined.
