of Forestry No. 102/Menhut-II/2006 dated 11 April 2006 for an area of approximately 11,830 ha. Jo Decree No. 60/Menhut-II/2013 dated 23 January 2013 of approximately 11,927.15 ha at Kuala Kampar Sub-district, Pelalawan Regency, Riau Province. The Management Unit advises that in the work areas there are areas of natural forest that were converted on December 31, 2010 covering an area of 443.4 hectares, which is not registered for certification. Thus the scope of the certification is for 11,483.75 hectares

PT Satria Perkasa Agung Unit Serapung is located at 102°57′53″ to 103°06′14″ E and 00°26′03″ to 00°37′13″ N, including watershed (DAS) and forest group Sei Kampar Kampar. The land conditions are peat swamp and thus the type cultivated is *Acacia crassicarpa*. Working area boundaries are as follows: northern border was the previous concession area (HPH) PT Alam Wana Sakti, eastern border with Selat Panjang coastal border, southern border with Kampar River border and western border with PT. MHJ and Serapung Village Forest.

In carrying out its operations, PT Satria Perkasa Agung Unit Serapung complies with all regulations and other requirenments: protected area, biodiversity, social aspects, and health and safety, as well as international conventions ratified by the Government of Indonesia such as CITES, ILO, ITTA and CBD

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The Management Unit has conducted spatial planning of the total concession area as follows: staple plant area 7,926.00 ha (66.45%); seed plant area 1205.15 ha (10.10%); livelihood plant area 785.00 ha (6.58%); non-productive/ infrastructure facilities 473 ha (3.97%); and protected areas 1,538.00 ha (12.89%). In carrying out its sustainable economic production the Management Unit has implemented management systems based on documented procedures, each process being carried out in accordance with its relevant SOP.

In its forest management practices the Management Unit applies the principles of P (Plan), D (Do), C (Check), A (Action), which include production, ecological and social aspects. Implementation is carried out based on the Revised Work Plan for Utilization of Forest Timber Plantation Industries (RKUPHHK-HTI) and the Annual Work Plan for Utilization of Forest Timber Plantation Industries (RKTUPHHK-HTI). Implementation activities include structuring the work area, land preparation, planting, maintenance, harvesting, management of forest products, as well as environmental and social activities.

In meeting its environmental responsibilities the Management Unit performs management of the ecosystem and hydrological functions, as well as of the biodiversity and undertaking forest protection. Management Unit has an Environment Document (AMDAL 2003). The Management Unit carries out its environmental management duties through the Environmental Management Plan (RKL) and Environmental Monitoring Plan (RPL) to minimize the negative impacts and enhance environmental quality in the work area, the documentation being reported to the Regional Environmental Agency (BLHD) each semester. In so doing, the following physio-chemical activities are carried out to monitor: micro climate, soil fertility, ground water level, ground subsidence, hydrology / water balance, water quality and fire hazard. Meanwhile, biological monitoring covers such areas as: types of protected vegetation, non-timber forest products, diversity and dispersion of wildlife species, and plant pests and diseases.

The Management Unit also manages and monitors the social environment. This includes employment and business opportunities, community economics, health and education, rights to non-timber forest resources, land tenure, and perception of company, as well as workers' right and occupational health and safety (K3).

In managing negative impact on the local community, the Management Unit has implemented the following:

- 1. Realization of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) program in 2015 and plans for its 2016 CSR program.
- 2. Dissemination activities to change the public perception of the company.
- 3. Provision of opportunities for the local community in the form local contractors, business growth stalls and hiring as employees.
- 4. Providing access to exploit non-timber forest products (NTFP).

Prior to performing its Surveillance 1 Audit, PT. AJA Sertifikasi Indonesia. conducted public consultation commencing May 2, 2016, asking stakeholders to provide feedback on PT Satria Perkasa Agung Unit Serapung. The public consultation was uploaded to the PT. AJA Sertifikasi Indonesia website (<u>www.ajaindonesia.com</u>), sent to the parties via email or postal mail, and published in a local newspaper. No input was received from stakeholders during the public consultation. The audit team also gathered information from the mass media about PT Satria Perkasa Agung Serapung Unit, in which was considered as part of the audit process.

PT Satria Perkasa Agung Unit Serapung has registered its concession to be certified in an area of 11,483.75 hectares. The Management Unit has identified all the necessary requirements for this certification process, comprising legal aspects that include compliance with local regulations and international conventions.

Findings on the certified client conformity with the certification requirements and description of critical issues in relation to the conformity.

The results of this Surveillance 1 Audit identified only three (3) minor items of non-compliance. There were no critical issues relating to conformity to certification standards. The Management Unit has already taken remedial action to address these non-conformities, which are now closed.
